Funding Tips

- Develop a project that is innovative, well-thought out, and has clearly defined objectives.
- Identify the goals of the funding program and relate your submission to those goals.
- Be focused, clear, and concise. Remember your application will be one of a vast number.
- Make sure all items on the application form are complete.
- Prepare your proposal early. Do not rush.
- Proofread! First, have someone review the proposal for clarity and consistency. Then proofread a second time for accuracy and completeness.
- Build a relationship with the funding agency. Don't be afraid to ask for advice in developing the project concept and/or preparing the funding application.
